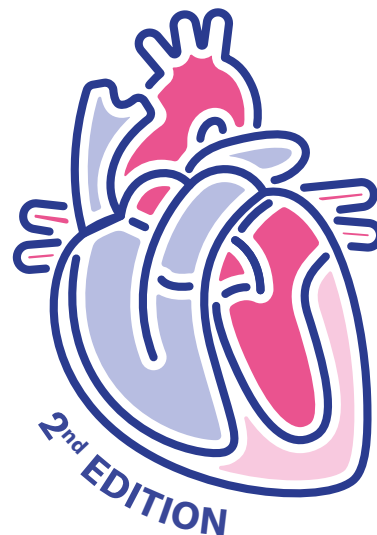

INTERVENTIONAL TREATMENT OF STRUCTURAL HEART DISEASE WITH MULTIMODALITY IMAGING

TOPICS: degenerative and congenital aortic valve disease, rheumatic and degenerative mitral stenosis, primary and secondary mitral regurgitation, tricuspid regurgitation, congenital pulmonary valve disease; bioprosthetic valve failure (structural valve degeneration and paravalvular leakage); grow-up congenital heart disease (atrial and ventricular septal defect, aortic coarctation, patent foramen ovale); post-infarction ventricular septal defect.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES: from A to Z. From diagnosis to clinical indications, multimodality imaging screening and procedural planning, step-by-step procedures, management of complications, follow-up.

TRANSCATHETER PROCEDURES: aortic valvuloplasty, all round transcatheter aortic valve replacement with different prosthesis and vascular approaches, transcatheter mitral and tricuspid valve repair/replacement, pulmonary valve replacement, valve-in-valve and THV-in-THV procedures, patent foramen ovale occlusion, atrial and ventricular septal defect occlusion, paravalvular leakage occlusion, left atrial appendage occlusion.
