

Supporting TAlent in ReSearch@ University of Padua

The STARS funding programme welcomes young pioneers of frontier research, offering support to ground-breaking ideas with definite potential to turn into competitive proposals for international funding, including the prestigious ERC grants.

STARS grants are open to all scientific areas and will **support research projects of 30 months** to be developed in one of the 32 Departments of the University of Padua.

STARS Starting Grants (StG) target PIs of any age and nationality, who intend to establish their own team and launch an independent research. Successful candidates will get a fixed-term position of 30 months in Padua. Applicants must have defended their first Doctoral Degree between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2022.

STARS Consolidator (CoG) and Wild Card Grants (WiC) target PIs who have already established their research activity in Padua and wish to consolidate their team, developing new ideas and projects. STARS CoG must have defended their first Doctoral Degree between 1 January 2013 and 31 December 2018.

Excellence is the only way to the STARS

Projects are evaluated based on their innovative nature, ambition and feasibility. PIs will be rewarded for their scientific skills, creativity and commitment. Successful PIs, once enrolled in the STARS programme, will receive full support to submit an **ERC application**, choosing Padua as their Host Institution, either during the project or immediately after.

What we offer

STARS Grants entail a research budget of up to 100,000 € (Social Sciences and Humanities) or 175,000 € (Physical Sciences and Engineering, Life Sciences) for 30 months, plus a fellowship for the PI of up to 100,000 € gross amount for 30 months, equivalent to 40,000 € gross amount/year or ca. 32,000 € net amount/year. Researchers from abroad benefit from an extra Mobility allowance of 15,000 € (gross amount for 30 months).
